In-Person Event FAQ

How do I register for the event?

There are two ways to register for International Stroke Conference 2022, in-person or online.

In-Person

Attendees can register at the registration desk in Hall D Lobby of the Ernest N. Morial Convention Center. Attendees who register to attend the conference in-person will also receive access to the conference online. Be sure to check your registration confirmation email which will contain your registration number (required to access the conference online).

Online

Attendees can register for this year's conference by visiting strokeconference.org and clicking the "Register Now" button.

How do I access the virtual event?

After registering, attendees will receive a confirmation email that includes their First Name, Last Name, Registration/Badge Number, **save this communication**. On February 7, all registrants will receive a follow-up communication that includes First Name, Last Name, Registration/Badge Number and the link to access the virtual event.

How will the content be delivered?

Programming will be presented both on-site in New Orleans, Louisiana and virtually in a combination of formats including live and on demand sessions.

Live Sessions will be available for replay within one hour after they conclude airing live. **On Demand content will be available within 24 hours of the session concluding on-site in New Orleans.**

Will sessions be available for viewing online after the last day of the event?

Registered attendees, for both the in-person and virtual events, will have access to the virtual content to view at their convenience for up to 30-days from the end of the conference until March 11th, 2022. All attendees will need is their Last Name (as registered) and their Registration/Badge Number to access the virtual conference. **Please note that enduring CE credit is not available on this platform.**

Need more time to view all the virtual ISC 2022 content? **Stroke OnDemand Extended Access** will launch on March 14th and will grant access to content through January 31st, 2023. Will Continuing Education Credit be offered?

International Stroke Conference, Nursing Symposium & HEADS UP Pre-Conference Symposia Professional Attendees (Physicians, Nurses and Physician's Assistants) will be able to claim CE credit after attending the meeting. All credit **MUST** be claimed within 6 months. We strongly encourage you to claim within the first 30 days.

To claim CE credit, access any computer with an internet connection visit learn.heart.org, select activities in progress, select ISC 2022, complete the conference evaluation and claim CE credits. An email will be sent to registrants with credit claiming instructions once attendance is verified. Credit Claim Instructions are also available at the Lifelong Learning pod of Headquarters in the Technology Hall and the Communications Center.

All ISC CE credits must be claimed by August 11, 2022.

All Nursing Symposium and HEADS UP Pre-Conference Symposia CE credit must be claimed by August 8, 2022.
