Registration

How do I register for the event?

Please visit professional.heart.org and click the Register Now button.

- Individual attendees are required to have a Professional Heart Daily profile to register. To create a profile, go to <u>Professional Heart Daily</u>, click the "Login" button in top right-hand corner, then click "Sign-up". If you have previously set up an account on PHD, but are unable to locate your login information, please click <u>here</u>.
- Forgot your password? Please go here.
- If you register to attend this year's conference in person, you will also receive access to the conference online. Look for your registration confirmation email containing your registration number (required to access the conference online).
- For group registration, please go here. You will find a form at the bottom of the page to complete & submit. From there, the Group Registration team will review your submission and respond to you with any questions or next steps.

How do I access the virtual event?

On Monday, February 5th, the Virtual Platform opens at 1pm MT (Phoenix); all registrants will receive a follow-up confirmation email and a link to access the virtual event.

Click the link provided in your email, upon first login, you will be asked to enter your email and password associated with your AHA Professional Heart Association account. Forgot your password? <u>Click here</u> to reset your password.

Membership

How will the content be delivered?

Programming will be presented on-site in Phoenix, AZ, and virtually through live-streamed and on-demand sessions. *On-Demand content will be available within 24 hours of the session concluding on-site in Phoenix.*

Will sessions be available for viewing after the last day of the event?

Registered attendees will have access to the virtual content to view at their convenience for up to 7 days from the end of the conference through Friday, February 16th, 2024 at 11:59am MT. All attendees will have access to the virtual conference.

IMPORTANT: CE credit is only available to claim for sessions viewed during the live portion of the meeting from **February 6 – 9**. CE is not available for sessions viewed after **February 9, 2024**. You will need to claim credit commensurate with the hours of accredited content viewed over the three days. **You can claim credit only once for the entire conference**.

Can I get Stroke OnDemand if I need more time to view sessions or need CE credit? Need more time to view all the virtual ISC 2024 content? Stroke OnDemand will launch on Tuesday, February 20th, and grant access to over 100 sessions, with CE opportunities available on selected sessions through January 31st, 2025.

With Stroke OnDemand, CE will be available for selected sessions. Pricing is \$299 for AHA Professional Members and \$499 for Non-Members. Before the conference, Stroke OnDemand is only available for purchase with registration as part of Gold package registration. If you have already registered for the conference, but did not originally purchase Gold package registration, you can upgrade your registration to Gold package via the Registration Resource Center for the +\$299/+\$499 price in addition to your registration cost.

<u>Stroke OnDemand</u> will launch on Tuesday, February 20th, and grant content access through **January 31**, **2025**. Over 100 sessions Enduring CE will be available for selected sessions.

How do I navigate the event platform?

AHA has designed a simple navigation method for attendees. At the top of the event platform home page, attendees have 4 main options to choose from:

- Home Lobby page Virtual Concierge, ePosters and AHA Membership
- Sessions
- Itinerary
- Speakers

Is there an agenda for the event?

Attendees can access the schedule of events via the <u>Online Program and Itinerary Planner</u> or the <u>Mobile App</u>. Additionally, there is an overview of the event platform under "Schedule at a Glance" in the Mobile App. There is also an overview schedule, and a filter in the Zoom Events platform that you can bookmark the sessions you are interested in watching.

How do I access ePosters

Attendees can view the International Stroke Conference 2024 ePosters beginning February 7 at 8 am MT (Phoenix). Late-Breaking Science ePosters are embargoed until the date/time of their presentation.

To <u>view the ePosters</u>, you will be prompted to login with your Last Name and Badge/Registration Number.

Attendees can view the ePosters, read the abstracts, listen to any audio recording, or video, and send questions to the presenters via email using the "Ask the Author" feature. Enjoy abstracts and audio recordings in the palm of your hand!

A link to view ePosters can be found in the information tab of the **AHA Conferences** mobile app.

Will Continuing Education credit be offered?

IMPORTANT: CE credit is only available to claim for sessions viewed during the live portion of the meeting from **February 6 – 9**. CE is not available for sessions viewed after **February 9, 2024**.

Professional attendees will be able to claim up to **22.0 CE credits** for participation in the ISC virtual conference activity. CE credit information for the State-of-the-Science Nursing Symposium and Pre-Conference Symposia is posted on our <u>Continuing Education</u> page.

Instructions for Claiming CE Credits for International Stroke Conference

- 1. Log in
 - a. Go to AHA's Professional Education hub at Intelligohub.org (link opens in new window)
 - b. Sign in with your username and password.
 - c. Click My Library.
 - d. Select the appropriate activity (i.e. International Stroke Conference 2024, Nursing Symposium, etc.).
- 2. Claim Credit
 - a. Complete the conference evaluation survey.
 - b. Click Claim CE.
 - c. Complete information and save.
 - d. Your certificate is located in 'My Account' under "CE Details."

All credit MUST be claimed within 6 months. We strongly encourage you to claim within the first 30 days.

You will need to claim credit commensurate with the hours of accredited content viewed over the live meeting. You can claim credit only **once** for the entire conference.

To claim live CE credit: the attendee can be in person or virtually watch the live streamed activities. Live CE credit cannot be issued for anything attended/viewed outside of the live activities' event date(s).

- Pre-conference symposia: The event date for all pre-conference symposia is February 6th.
 Only livestreamed content viewed on that date is eligible for CE credit.
- o **ISC Main Conference:** The event dates for ISC are February 7-9th. Only livestreamed content viewed during those dates are eligible for CE credit.

IMPORTANT: All ISC CE credits must be claimed by August 9, 2024. All Nursing Symposium and Pre-Conference Symposia CE credit must be claimed by August 6, 2024.

Statement for International Attendees: At this time, we are unable to offer CE credit claim to participants residing outside of the United States. We apologize for this inconvenience.

Technical Issues

What is the best browser to access ISC24 online?

We support the most current version of the popular browsers: Chrome, Safari, Edge, and Firefox.

Unable to login?

- Ensure that you are disconnected from the institution/company VPN. If they are unable to disconnect from their VPN, please share this <u>direct Zoom event link</u> with them (too long to share via phone).
- There might be a problem with the web browser's cache and cookies. Try logging in using an "incognito" feature (which usually ignores all your stored cache and cookies). *While using incognito, some site features may not function properly.
- If logging in via incognito works, you might need to clear your browser's cache and cookies to be able to log in from a normal window again.

How to Clear Browser Cache

Every browser has a different way of clearing cache and cookies, so you will have to check how to do this depending on what you are using.

Chrome

- On your computer, open Chrome.
- At the top right, click the 3 stacked dots.
- Click "More tools".
- Click "Clear browsing data."
 - o At the top, choose a time range.
 - o To delete everything, select All time
 - Next to "Cookies and other site data" and "Cached images and files", check the boxes.
 - o Click "Clear data".

Edge

- On your computer, open Edge.
- Press the keys [Ctrl], [Shift] and [Del].
- A new Window opens. Select the option "temporary services and files".
- Confirm your selection by clicking on the "delete" button.

FireFox

- Click the menu button at the top right (3 stacked lines) and select "Settings".
- Select the "Privacy & Security" panel.
 - o In the "Cookies and Site Data" section, click "Clear Data".
 - o Remove the checkmark in front of "Cookies and Site Data".
 - o With "Cached Web Content" check marked, click the "Clear" button.
 - o Close the "about: preferences" page.

Safari

- Open "Settings".
- Tap "Safari".
- Tap "Clear History and Website Data"

Trouble logging in: Corporate IT Settings / Antivirus and Firewall Software

Some corporate IT settings will block websites. These corporate Antivirus and Firewall software sometimes automatically block certain websites out of minor suspicions, and the web page following the login page might have been blocked, causing you to be unable to login. If you think there might be a problem with your Antivirus or Firewall software, you can try logging in using a different device. For example, if you normally log in from a desktop computer, try logging in using your mobile phone.

Troubleshooting Livestream:

- Turn off Ad-Blocker on your browser
- Login using a personal device
