

OnDemand Extended Access F.A.Q.

What is OnDemand Extended Access? OnDemand Extended Access is the collection of the recorded educational sessions from our Scientific Sessions 2020 and International Stroke Conference 2021 virtual events.

How is this different from the on demand access I get with my event registration? OnDemand Extended Access is available for up to 1-year from the end of the conference while the on-demand access included with attendee registration is only available for 30 days. Additionally, attendee registration does not include enduring CME/CE opportunities, only live credit.

For Scientific Sessions 2020, AMA, ANCC and CAPCE credits must be claimed within 6 months of attendance. CME/CE credit will no longer be available to claim after May 17, 2021. ACPE credit must have been claimed within 30 days of attendance. ACPE credit is no longer available to claim as of December 17, 2020.

For International Stroke Conference 2021, AMA & ANCC Credits must be claimed within 6 months of attendance. CME/CE credit will no longer be available to claim after September 19, 2021.
