We will collaborate with the Patient Integration and Guidelines staff to explore the possibility of expanding the role of lay stakeholders in communicating the American Heart Association guidelines to patients. Interviews focused on the 2024 Atrial Fibrillation Guidelines will educate lay audiences about these clinical guidelines and the role lay stakeholders play in their development.
