Score Scale	Evaluation of Program Criteria Descriptions
1	Exceptional Science, no weaknesses on program criteria
2	Outstanding Science, minor weaknesses on program criteria
3	Excellent Science, more strengths than weaknesses on program criteria
4	Very Good Science, minor weaknesses on program criteria
5	Good Science, strengths and weaknesses are equivalent on program criteria
6	Satisfactory Science, weaknesses are greater than strengths on program criteria
7	Fair Science, weaknesses are greater than strengths on program criteria
8	Marginal Science, too many weaknesses in program criteria
9	Poor Science, little to no strengths in program criteria
